

Assistance for using the app

Purpose: Guitar Fretboard Scale is an app designed to help guitarists understand and learn the guitar neck, scales and triads, to broaden the knowledge necessary to start improvising.

Composition: the entire app is based on a main view, duly optimized based on the device in use and its orientation, which presents a legend and a series of menus and submenus that determine what is displayed in the body of the screen.

In particular, five menus at the top allow you to select one of the 5 boxes of the pentatonic scale and "expand" them in order to move from the simple pentatonic to the blues scale, to the complete one or to display the notes of the major and minor arpeggio.

The menus at the bottom, similarly, allow you to choose whether to display the boxes of the scales composed with three notes per string; to display the boxes in blocks of 3 at a time; the geometries of the guitar, in order to be able to identify the same notes, but on different strings and finally the triads and their alterations.

Finally, a special button allows you to view a practical metronome, useful for having a rhythmic guide that you can use to practice performing scales in time, without having to leave the app.
